

# Good Day Lounge Chair

Chaise Lounge



Creativity sparks creativity. The Good Day Lounge Chair was inspired by an artist recording a song in the music studio. Working with another artist, the two complimented each other's artistic styles with a play between powerful and smooth. Once fully immersed in the music, a low-lying chaise lounge chair seemed an appropriate design direction to capture the moment. The concept was to have a thin floating seat suspended under a crossbar attached to heavier structural legs. The seat would appear light and floating, yet grounded by the leg structure. Watching the 2 artists work together it seemed appropriate to contrast their different styles within the forms of the chair.



The clean lines of the Good Day lounge requires clean leather pads where stitching doesn't distract from the aluminum forms. Leather is wet formed in molds then glued to the pads for a clean, stitch free look.

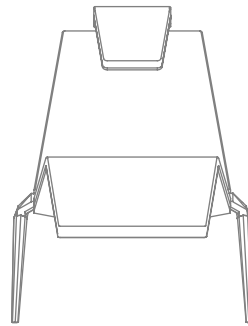
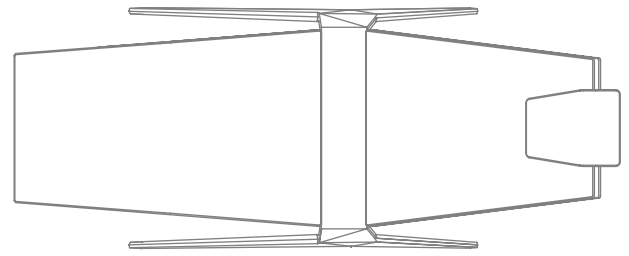
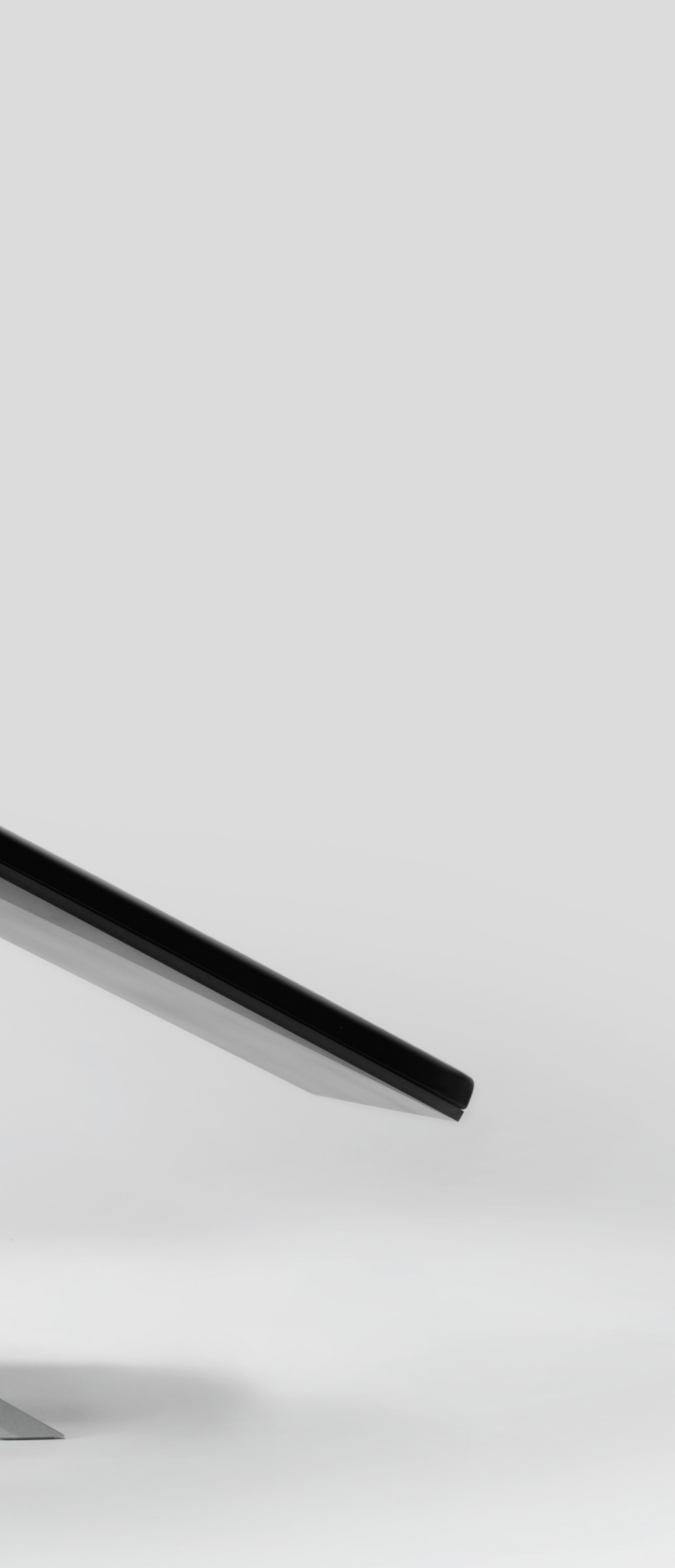




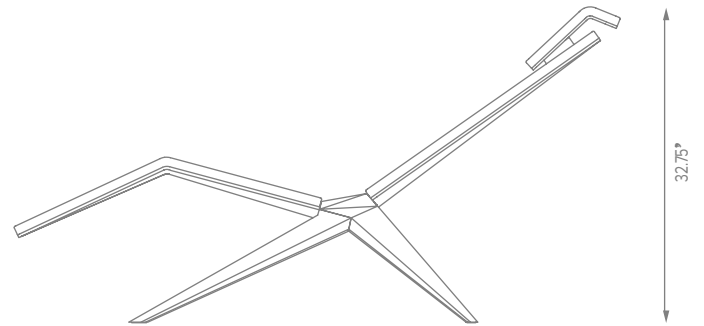


Having a thin structure suspended below a frame proved a difficult engineering feat. The cast aluminum seat requires a steel structural frame to be internal to the casting to carry the load without allowing the aluminum seat to yield. Once assembled, the internal steel frame is hidden beneath the leather pads.
