We invented our Loop Bodysuit to solve this problem. Its unique and clever minimalist design has no fiddly buttons or ties and grows along with your baby for many months.

The Loop Bodysuit is made of a stretchy, supple cashmere-modal blend that is comfortable and soft on baby's skin. It stretches to hug your baby's shape, allowing space for bulky cloth diapers and protecting their sensitive torso from cold and drafts.

The highlight of this completely new type of bodysuit is in the name:

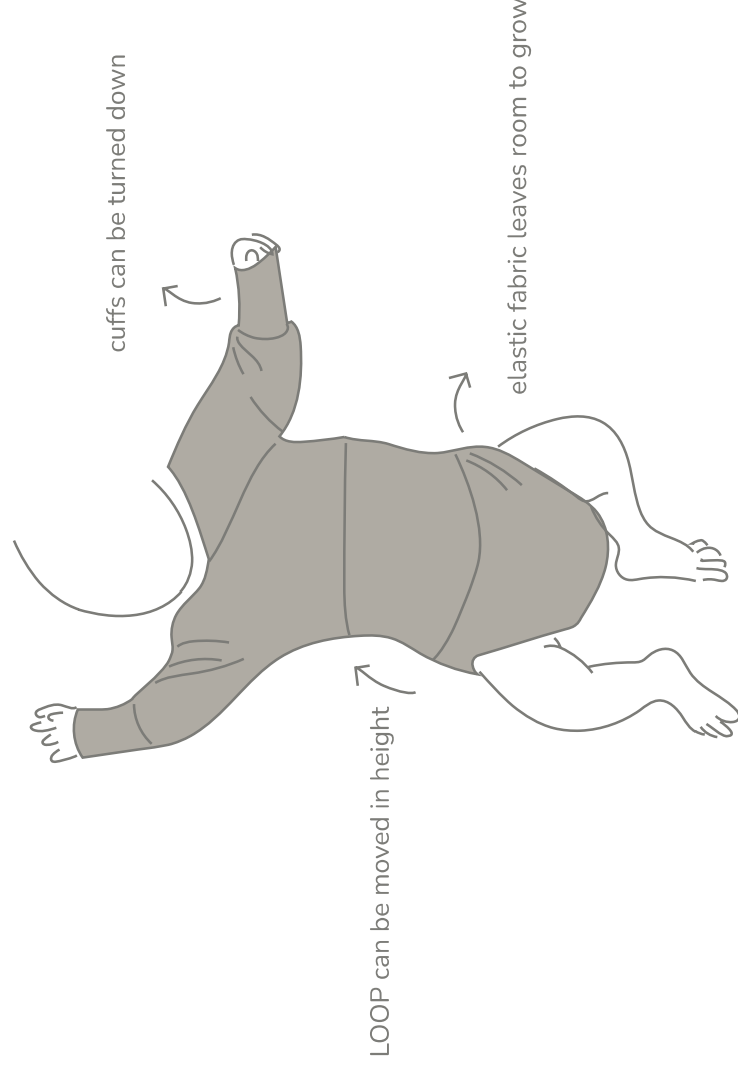
its patent-pending loop. The loop encircles baby's tummy with a wide, comfortable layer that never pulls or pinches. And the best part?

The Loop Bodysuit makes dressing and undressing easier and quicker for caretakers: no more nerve-wracking diaper changes spent wrestling with the tiny snaps of conventional bodysuits.

Very small babies may not like having clothes pulled on over their heads, so the Loop Bodysuit is also designed for easy dressing from the bottom up. The Loop Bodysuit simplifies nighttime changes, too: even the most sleep-deprived new parent will be able to change baby in the dark once they've used the Loop a few times.

The simple and completely unique design of the Loop Bodysuit makes it an essential and invaluable basic for every baby's first wardrobe.

How to Loop...

Start by dressing baby as you would with a normal bodysuit: hands through sleeves. Then you'll have the panel underneath the baby: the part you'd normally pull through to fasten over their diaper. At the long end of this panel is the loop. The backside of the loop will be facing up (you'll see the upside-down PETIT CO-CHON label at the lower edge of the loop). Put baby's little legs through the loop, just like a pair of trousers. Pull the loop up to cover baby's belly and you're done! See, that was easy! And faster than fiddling with the snaps on a normal bodysuit. Less fuss for you, less fuss for baby, and more time for those precious baby snuggles.
