# "MAY I?" CONDOM





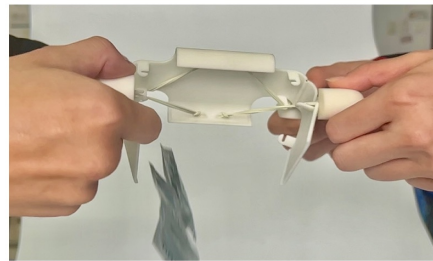
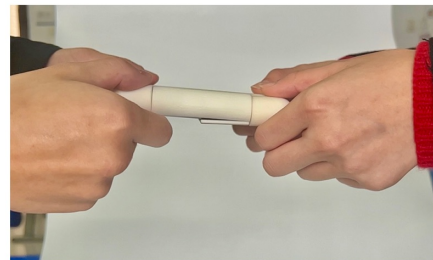
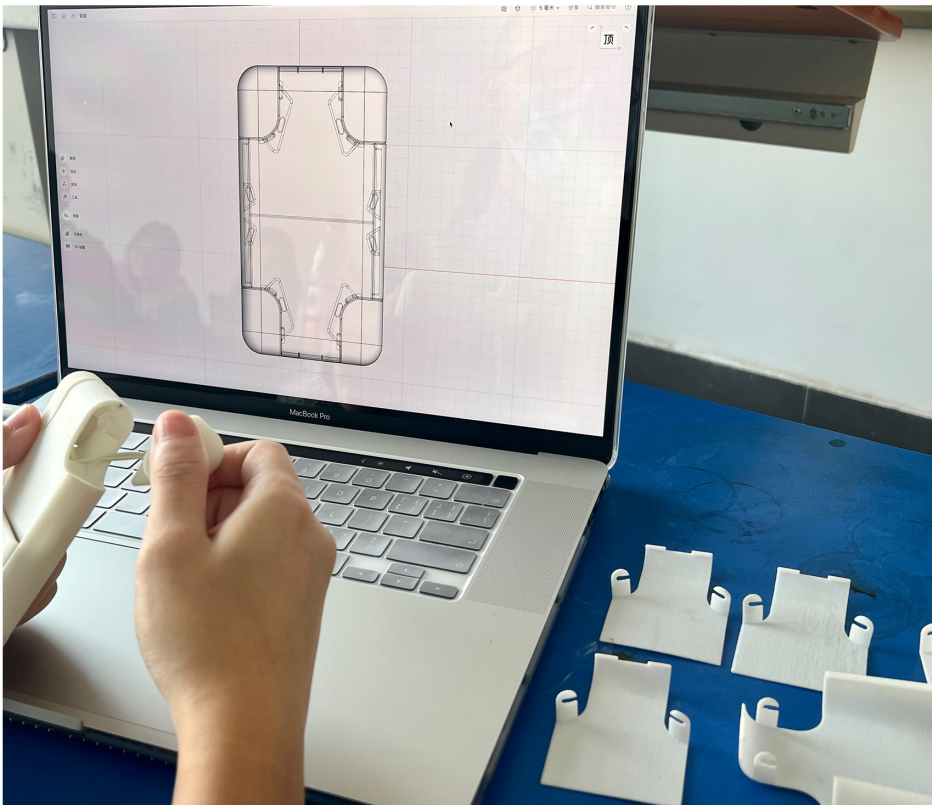
## Introduction

"MAY I?" Condom packaging is designed to enhance sexual consent in sexual activity so the box requires two people to open it together. It is difficult for one person to open the two bottom lids, but two people can easily open it.

This does not mean "MAY I?" Condom packaging will be an indestructible box, and we can't prevent the user from opening it through non-compliant means, just as we can't avoid sexual assault. Rather than focusing on how to prevent users from getting condoms, this design project instead explored how to improve the public awareness of sexual consent. It transforms the active and passive relationship in sexual activity into an equal relationship.

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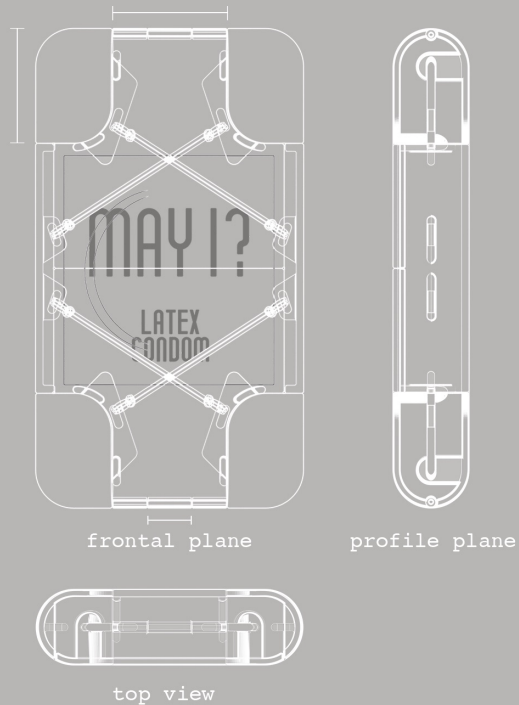
## Usability test - prototype



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## Assembled

The main body of the case is composed of two bottom lids, upper cover, and four corners. The four corners are used as a latch to fix the upper cover and the lower cover while being connected to the upper cover through a rubber band. The rubber band will prevent the removal of the four corners through multiple operations for one person. Only when two people pull the four corners at the same time will the bottom cover be opened, causing the condom to fall on the bed.





## Design concepts

### Metaphorical

The introduction of how to open "MAY I?" Condom packaging is relatively metaphorical, using only a few words and small images to explain, because the process of exploring how to open it together can also become part of the product experience.

### Neutral

"MAY I" condom packaging design follows neutral design principles and avoids predicting the answer to the question "May I?" The answer to this question can be "Yes" or "Sorry, no." Giving an honest answer without any guidance is the design goal of "May I?" condom packaging.
