




## Major challenges in after-retirement lives



#### Financial insecurity


The cost of care is high, and seniors lack sufficient resources

Seniors are more prone to be socially isolated and/or experience loneliness






## After-retirement job preference and social lives

- Who are seeking employment


answered questions about their job preferences after retirement and social lives.






## Demand survey on target audience, young adults











## Creating an age-friendly device design
