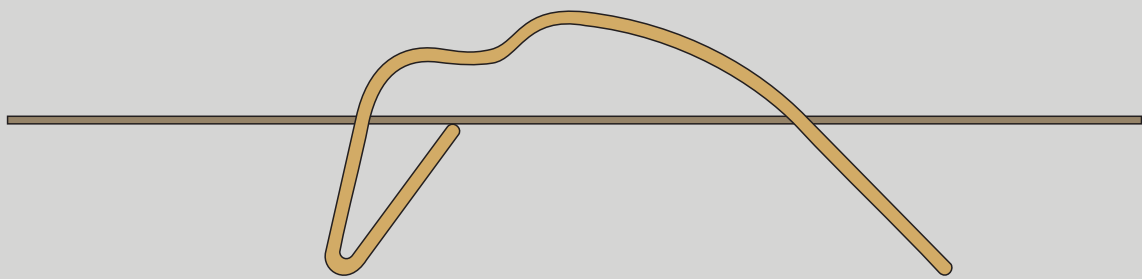
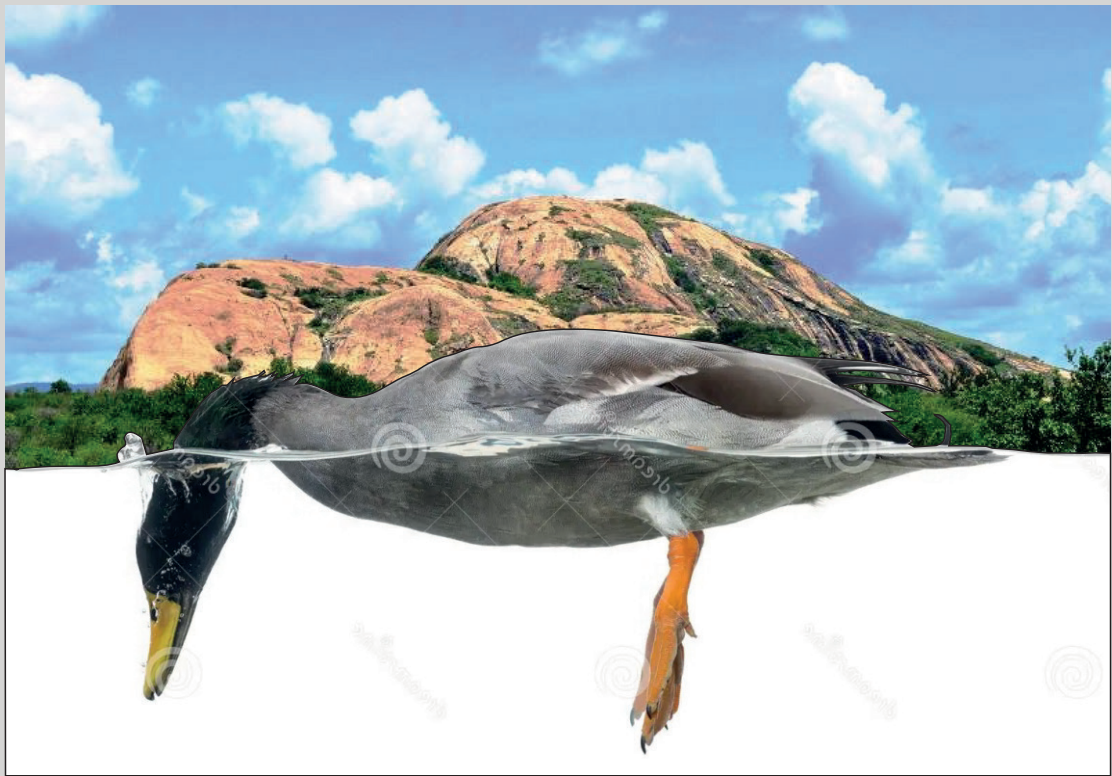


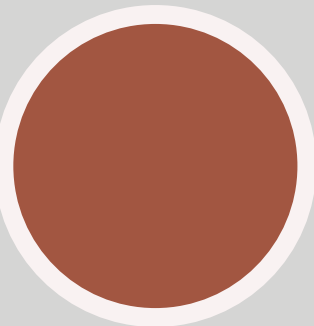
Coffee Table **Lapa**



INSPIRATION

The third most important city in Paraíba was named after the lake that, in the 17th century, bordered the Espinharas River. Known as Lagoa dos Patos, it received this name due to the large number of birds that lived there. Inspired by this rich history, the Lapa table captures the shapes of Lagoa dos Patos, the birds and the Serrote do Espinho Branco mountain. This design sparks the imagination, merging history, art and design in a single piece. Our intention was to combine facts and historical points of the city with organic shapes, widely used in the manufacture of contemporary furniture. Thus, we created a piece that is not only functional, but also a work of art that conveys history and poetry. "Lapa" means cave or cavity opened in the rock, a natural shelter. With this table, we hope to bring a little of this essence to your environment.
