

i-Mentor is a mobile app designed with social, privacy, and efficiency features to help mentees and mentors connect and get to know each other more effectively.


Challenge

Imagine you are a freshman, confused about many things, and urgently need an experienced mentor to help you adjust to campus life.




O₁ Efficiency

Available mentors to help mentee know who is available now


Category users needs into three themes: life, study and career based on the campus scenario. Allow user use filter to customized needs.


03 Social


Users have to answer a personality survey before sending a friend request
