A voice-assistant app to empower the elderly to actively participate, connect, and contribute, enriching their lives and strengthening their relationships with family members.



What challenges need to be addressed?

Limited Face-to-Face Interaction

Physical distance and the busy schedules of the younger generation pose a challenge to meaningful face-to-face communication with the elderly, hindering family bonds.



Loneliness and Limited Remote Communication

The absence of efficient remote contact methods leads to loneliness and disconnection among the elderly. Their inability to use smart devices due to physical, cognitive, and knowledge limitations exacerbates this challenge.



Low Family Activity Participation

Generation gaps, communication difficulties, and restricted activity options contribute to decreased family engagement and participation in activities, impacting overall family connectedness.

People are living longer – the number of older persons (aged 60 and above) is expected to more than **Double** globally by 2050 according to the UN. With the aging population grows, services and supports have been offered by different countries, organizations, and communities. However, this has inadvertently led society to perceive the elderly as vulnerable. **They also desire to contribute and connect, beyond just receiving assistance.**

User Interview

I interviewed my grandparents and some elderly neighbors about the topic to find their needs and challenges regarding initiative.



81 years old, living alone

Distance and limited mobility make socialization difficult, and I often feel lonely. It would be great if I could have connection with my family and friends from home.



72 years old, living with his wife

We want to meet our kids, but their busy schedules make coordinating times hard. Phone calls are cumbersome, and we aren't adept at using social apps.



74 years old, living with his Kids

I want to chat with my kids, but starting conversations with young people is hard. I have no idea of what they like. I'm sure we would have fun if there could be something to share.

As many elderly mentioned family, I subsequently interviewed their family members to gather their perspectives.

I'm occupied with work, and besides ensuring my parents' physical well-being, I lack time to provide them with emotional support.

I want to hear my grandparents' stories and feelings, but we struggle to find a good starting point for the conversation.

Challenges

Elderly

The interview has revealed that **physical, knowledge, and cognitive limitations** are major challenges for elderly socialization. They restrict elderly individuals' socializing options, tools, and content, making it challenging for them to proactively connect with others.



Younger generation

Additionally, the younger generation's limited time, energy, and generation gap pose challenges for meeting the elderly's emotional needs within the family.

Insights



Elders' desired social circles mainly include family

Interviews revealed that most seniors seek closer family ties and positive interactions with their family.



Family interactions involve numerous steps

Communication, coordination, preparations, and potential last-minute changes - all require efforts.



Multiple factors lead to low family engagement

The factors include, but are not limited to, generation gaps, limited activity choices, mismatched schedules, and declining cognitive abilities in the elderly.



Elderly need a simple, accessible social platform

Interview and research highlight the elderly's limited familiarity with smart devices, necessitating a senior-friendly platform to socialize more frequently from anywhere.



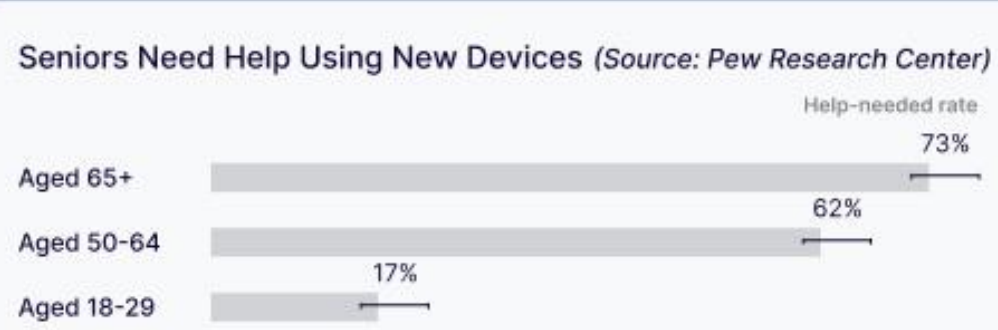
Remote connectivity is important for elderly and their family

It is vital to overcome barriers of coordinated in-person family activities caused by distance, schedules, and diverse lifestyles, enabling more frequent and closer family interactions.



Youth could address the challenges together

Interviews indicated that the younger generation is willing to provide more companionship and emotional support to the elderly, despite the lack of a suitable approach.

Reframe the Problem


Considering both the needs of the elderly and the potential of the younger generation's participation, I propose a social platform that focuses on enhancing active family connections for the elderly. The central question becomes:
How can we create an elderly-friendly platform that enhances active, effective, and flexible family interactions?

Designing Interface

Home page

The elderly can access related pages focusing on family activities and the symbol "Waterdrop".



Profile

Reminder and encouragement for family activity challenges through voice interaction.

- Update challenge progress
- Record family time on the platform
- Show the count of collected water droplets, linked to completed family activity challenges. Access to view specific activity details.

Access other pages to unlock diverse family activities, enjoy family time, and create colorful memories.

Wishing fountain

The elderly get family-activity inspirations from here.

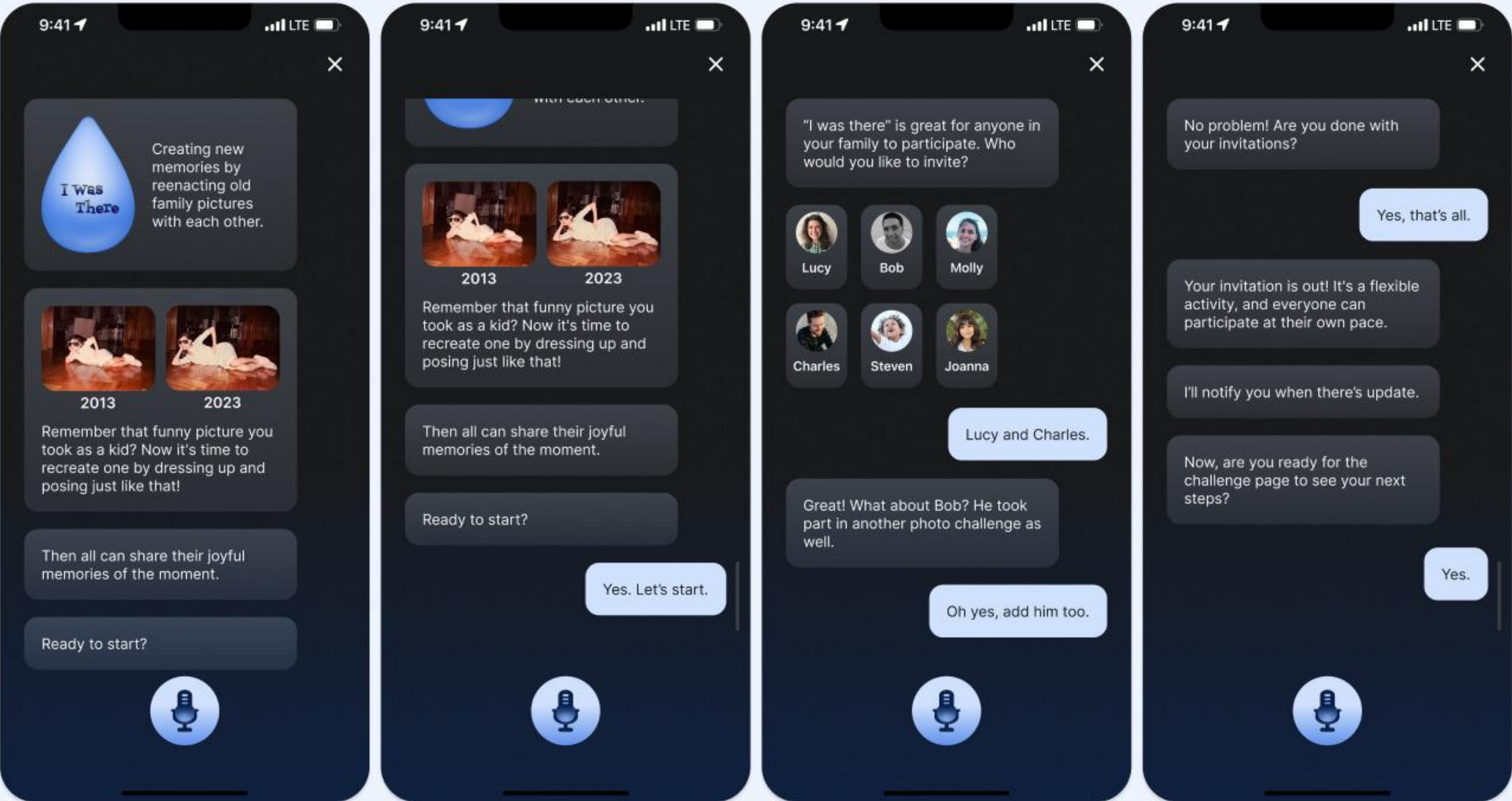
Guided by Voice Assistant, the elderly make wishes to the wishing fountain, select “synchronous” or “asynchronous” family activities, and view activity details from the correspondently released water droplets.



Activity intro & initiation

Voice Assistant guides the elderly to understand and initiate the family activity.

- Introduce activity information to the elderly through sound, text, and images for easy comprehension.
- Guide the elderly step by step in setting up activities.
- Offer personalized suggestions based on past records and family information.



Activity in progress - Asynchronous activity

Users view activity details and complete the challenge with Voice Assistant

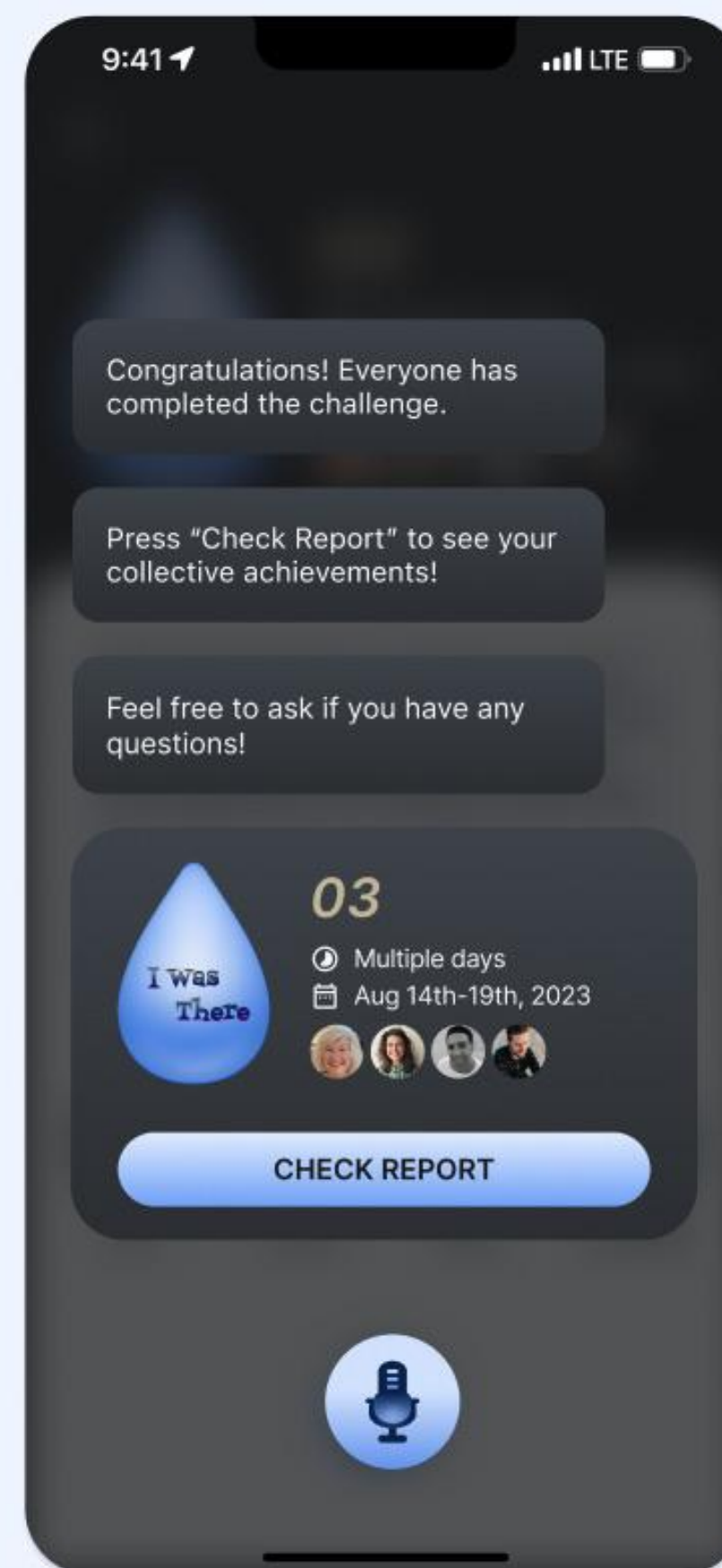
- Displays activity basics, rules, and participant progress.
- Voice Assistant is available for assistant at any time.



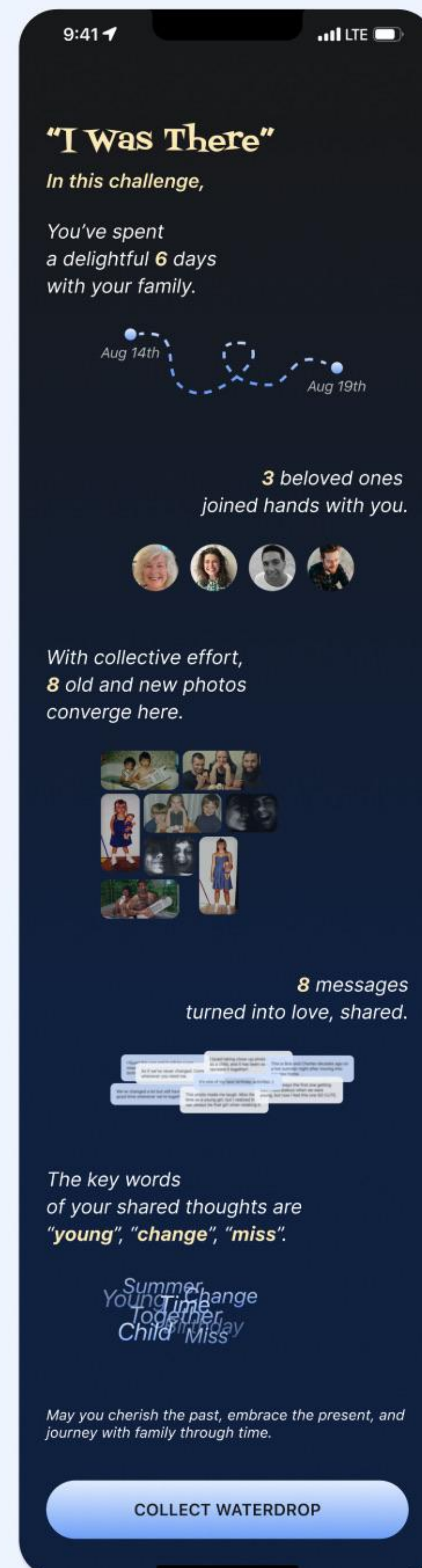
Challenge completed

Personalized memories are generated after challenge completion, viewed anytime.

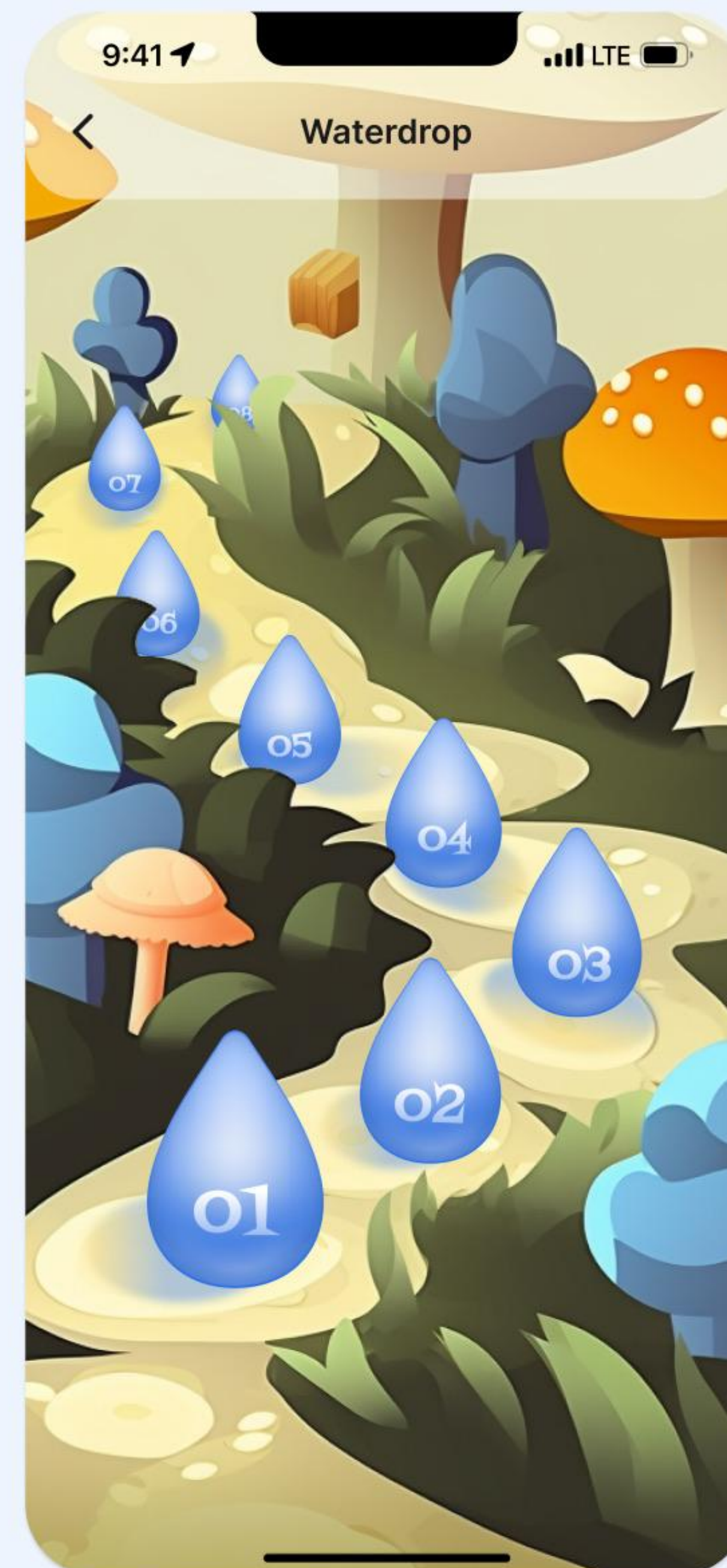
Designed with a "Nurturing the Family Garden" theme, this garden path features water droplets, each representing a family activity challenge. Water droplets collected along the path nurtures the family garden of love and stores family activity memories.



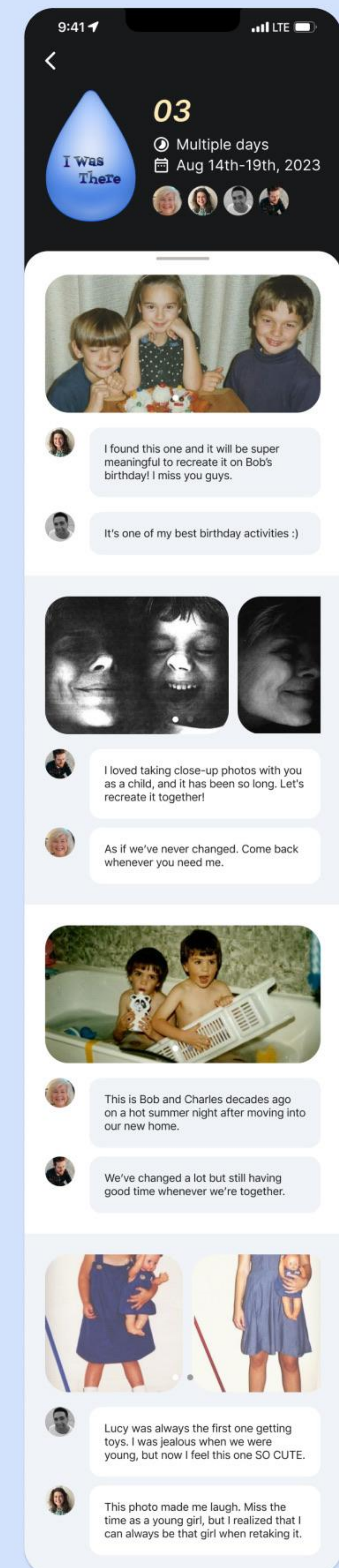
Create a unique activity report summarizing family achievements upon completion.



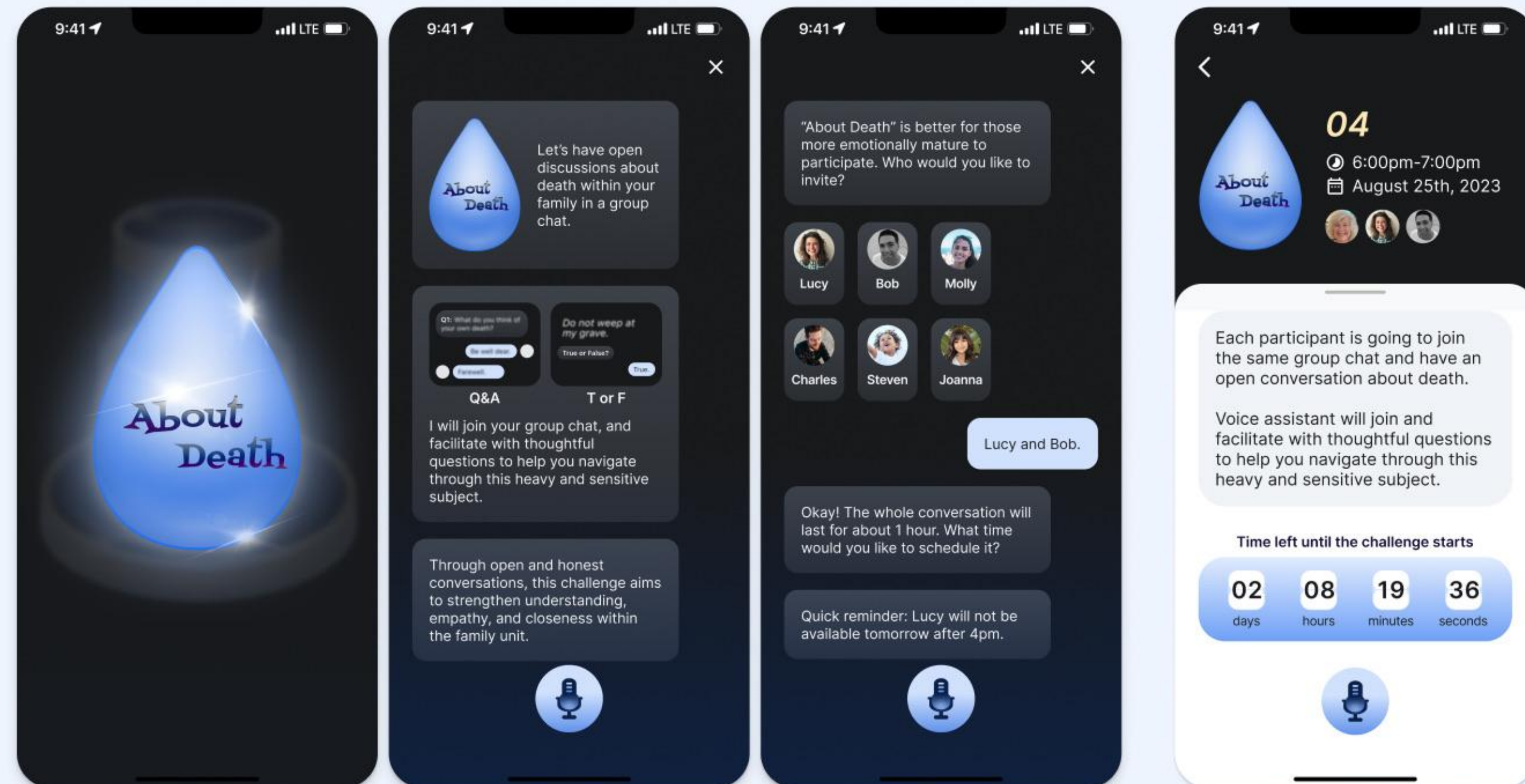
Completing a challenge collects a water droplet on the path.



Accessing any water droplet reveals the corresponding memory record.

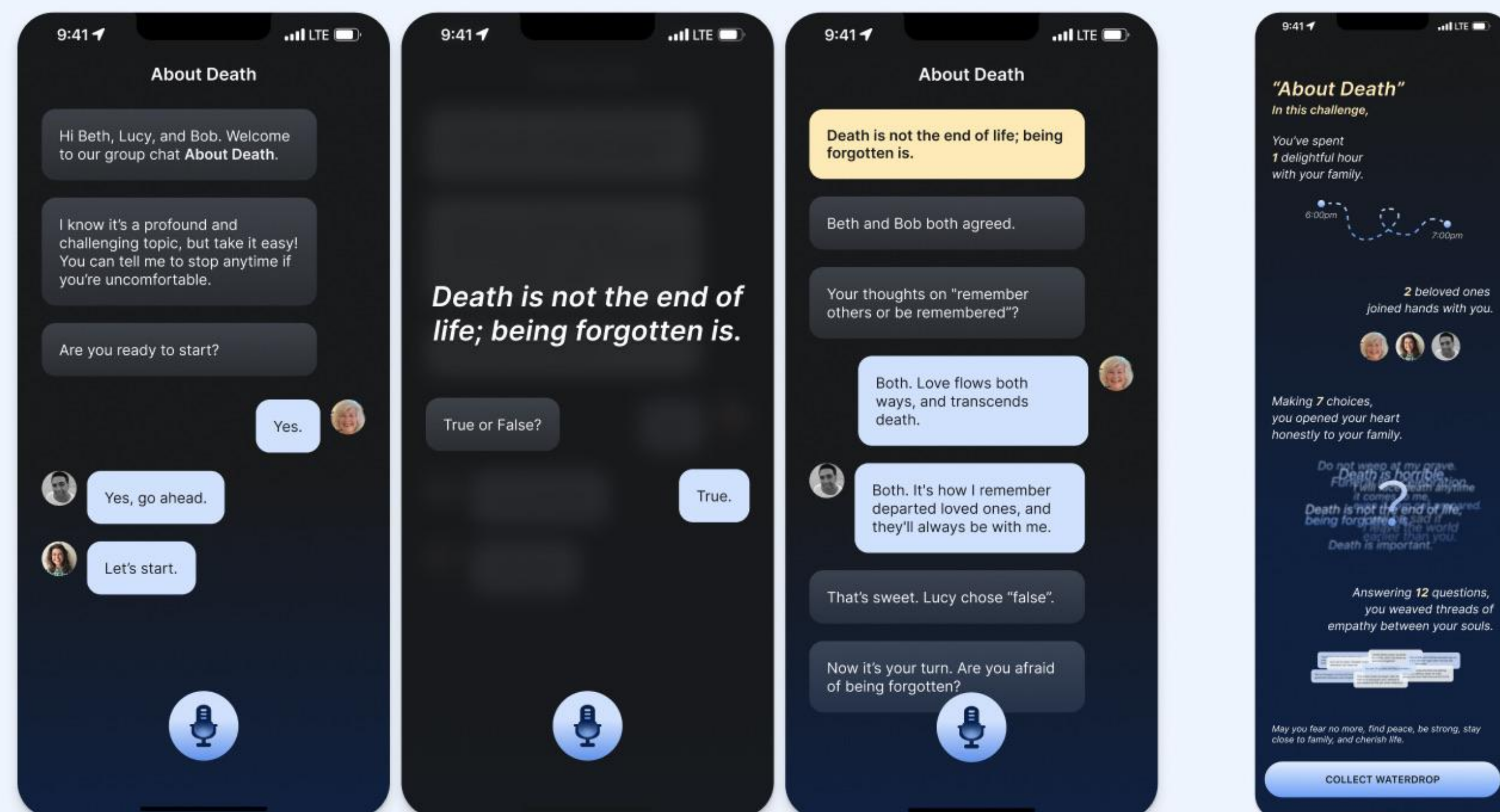
