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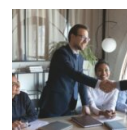

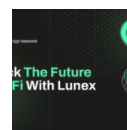

Despite understanding the possibility of compromised traffic signs, many participants overestimated AI's ability to detect such anomalies. This overconfidence could have dangerous consequences if drivers rely too heavily on autonomous systems in situations where AI is vulnerable to adversarial inputs.

## Addressing Vulnerabilities Through Education and Transparency

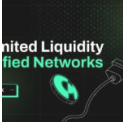
